# House of Broadcasting Fund-raiser

Annual celebrity roast honors, pokes fun at Jerry Colangelo



The Pointe Hilton Squaw Peak Resort hosted the seventh annual House of Broadcasting Museum Celebrity Roast recently. Jerry Colangelo, chairman and chief executive of the Phoenix Suns, was this year's honoree for his outstanding contributions to Phoenix and its thriving pro-sports franchises.

Connie Hawkins, one of the Suns' first super stars, Phoenix Mayor Phil Gordon, **Sen. Jon Kyl** and Phoenix Suns head coach Mike D'Antoni were among the many to share their experiences with Colangelo over the years. Al McCoy served as emcee.

"It's hard to overstate Jerry's contribution to the development of Phoenix," says Kyl. "He will go down in history for the things he's done here."

Colangelo's career in Phoenix began in 1968 when he was hired by the Suns. At 28, Colangelo was the youngest general manager in professional sports at the time. Since then, he has been integral to the success of the Suns as well as the inception of the Arizona Diamondbacks, Phoenix Mercury, Phoenix Coyotes and the building of the Dodge Theatre.

This year's event raised \$50,000 for general operating funds for the House of Broadcasting, says House of Broadcasting board member Mike Shaldjian. \*
